Who is responsible for your data?

In accordance with the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and Council, we inform you that the personal data provided will be processed by COMM Santé, 76, rue Marcel Sembat 33 323 Bègles Cedex France.

How do we use your personal information?

As part of our relationships, you are likely to communicate us your personal data by various ways and especially on our website, our mobile site during your internet browsing, purchases, booking, by completing the various collection forms, when subscribing to the e-newsletter, when creating an account, when you deposit an application, when you post comments on our social media pages, when you establish any contact with COMM Santé or when you send us any other way your personal data

Your collected data is necessary to be able to provide you with all the guarantees for the requested service, and will be processed with the following objectives:

- To provide the service requested by the user and which is offered by the website (its maintenance and its improvement), profiling, segmentation of your data and / or cross-referencing with other databases, under the responsibility of COMM Santé.
- To suggest promotions, offers or advertising actions related to the Customer's status, by electronic or other means of communication.

How long will you store my personal data for?

COMM Santé commits (or undertakes?) to keep your personal data for a period not exceeding that necessary of the purposes for which they are processed. In addition, COMM Santé keeps your personal data in accordance with the retention periods imposed by the applicable laws in force.

These retention periods are defined conforming to the processing purposes implemented by COMM Santé and in particular takes into account the applicable legal provisions imposing a precise retention period for certain categories of data, any potential limitation periods as well as the recommendations of the CNIL concerning certain categories of data processing (for example, Deliberation No. 2016-264 of July 21, 2016 amending a simplified standard concerning the automated processing of personal data relating to the management of customers and prospects (NS 048), article L.232-7 of internal security code relating to the transmission of passenger data to the French administration, storage of cookies for 13 months as recommended by the CNIL, etc.).

Sharing your personal data with others

In order to fulfill the planned objectives, your data may be communicated to:

- organizations or persons directly linked to the responsible person;
- courier companies to communicate offers;
- to administrations and legal authorities.
- and more specifically, all companies linked to the COMM Santé brand.

What are your rights when you entrust us your data?

Everyone has the right to request access, rectification, deletion, limitation of processing, opposition or right to portability of personal data, by writing to our above address or by sending an email to info@comm-sante.com, indicating the right that you want to apply.

You will also have the right to withdraw the consent given at any time. The withdrawal of consent will not affect the legality of the processing carried out before the withdrawal of said consent.

You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority if you believe that your rights have been violated in relation to the protection of your personal data.

In case of non-compliance with the use of your personal data
